New York-based Dimitriy & Co uses traditional techniques to hand-make upholstery, and the company's core collection runs the gamut of design influences from Belgian minimalist to Manhattan sleek. The Dahlem sofa (pictured), from the newly launched SS19 collection, appeals with its curved profile and chunky proportions. The rounded based is made from solid oak while the fabric is entirely customisable.
