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Its Place in the Footlights

Beds From Dmitriy & Company

David and Donna Feldman were looking for a balance between modernist rigor and antique embellishment when they began to produce their own furniture out of a workroom in Chelsea. They named the business Dmitriy & Company, inspired by Mr. Feldman's Russian-born grandfather, who had a pillow shop on the Lower East Side.

Their Seine bed (starting at \$12,800), which is upholstered in Belgian linen, is as inviting as a nest, while their Brugge bed, covered in a Loro Piana wool-and-cashmere blend (starting at \$11,700), has a flared leg for a spot of levity. The beds are designed without seams for a flowing profile.

They are “not meant to go against a wall,” Ms. Feldman said. “If someone wanted to float them in a fabulous loft or chateau, they would have design integrity appreciated from all sides.”
