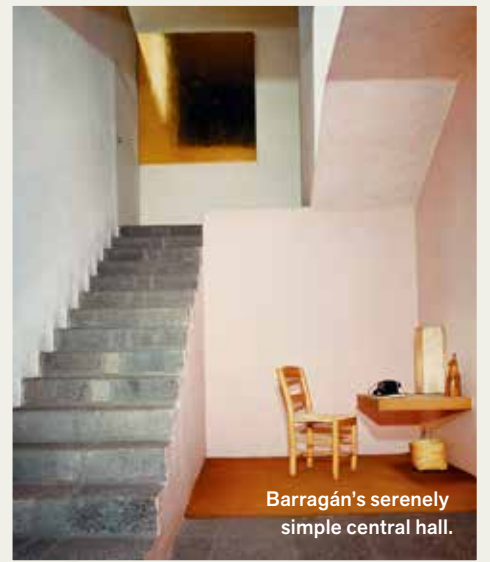

Barragán fused the International Style of Le Corbusier with a joyful essentialism that owed much to the indigenous vernaculars of his native Mexico. The results yielded hushed, happy spaces where comfort meets contemplation.
